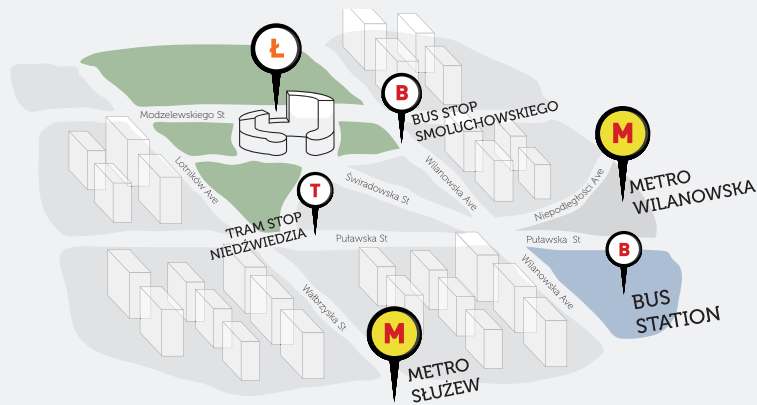


QUALITY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The educational programmes at Lazarski University combine the best in theoretical knowledge with the latest in practical application. DIVERSE STUDENT POPULATION

Lazarski University has around 4500 students studying in English or Polish. More than 80% of students in our English-language programmes come from outside Poland, from countries as diverse as the Netherlands, Georgia, Namibia, Ukraine, Belarus, Japan, Germany, Nepal, Turkey, Vietnam, and many more.



CONVENIENT LOCATION

Lazarski University is located in the south-western part of Warsaw, in the Mokotów district, and is a mere 4 metro stops away from the city centre. It is very easy to reach the university from all over Warsaw. The campus is also close to the main international airport in Warsaw, which is about 5 km away.

STUDENT SUPPORT

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

We have a wide variety of scholarships for students based on Academic, Athletic, or other notable merits and achievements that can be won throughout their time at Łazarski University. If you study well during your time at Łazarski and obtain an average of 4.40 – 4.79 you will get a 20% scholarship for the following academic year. If your average is 4.80 or above, you will a 30% scholarship!

ACCOMMODATION

The Accommodation Department provides many different housing solutions for our students. Students can stay in our student housing facilities such as one of the dormitories; alternatively, Łazarski University also cooperates with a number of real estate agencies to help students find the perfect place to live if they wish to look for their own apartment.



VISA AND LEGAL SUPPORT

The Student Help Desk is dedicated to helping new and current students adapt to life in Warsaw and at Lazarski University. The Student Help Desk offers free assistance to students with immigration issues, and provides a free advisory support service regarding health insurance, nostrification, and much more.



MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

There is a medical centre on campus, which is open to the public, and is operated by CenterMed. At CentreMed you can obtain a medical certificate, general medical advice, do your check-ups, and get treated for basic illnesses. If needed, CentreMed can also refer students for more specialized treatment in nearby hospitals.

STUDENT EXCHANGES

At Lazarski University, students also have an opportunity to study for one or two semesters at a partner university outside of Poland. Exchanges are available with over 90 different universities in countries like Germany, Belgium, Demark, Cyprus, France, Spain, Turkey, Vietnam, and many others. SINGLE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

➔ BA in Management

This programme is ideal for students who wish to pursue a managerial career and to solve real world business problems. As part of the programme, students may choose to specialize in [Logistics](#) or [Tourism and Travel Management](#).

➔ BA in Economics

This programme is intended to train students in the application of fundamental economic knowledge to real-life managerial, financial, ethical, and analytical problems encountered in business and economics. Students will specialise in [Business Economics](#) as part of the programme.

➔ BA in International Relations

This programme, with a specialisation in [European Studies](#), is for people who are curious about global affairs and who wish to exert an influence in both governmental and non-governmental institutions and business. ➔ MSc in Economics

Through this programme students will develop their skills and professional interests in economics to become key players in business, irrespective of the geographical location of their future job, by specialising in [International Business Economics](#)

PROGRAMS IN ENGLISH

DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

➤ BA in Business Economics

This is an innovative and unique programme that combines the scientific rigor of economics with the practicability of business, designed for future analysts, researchers, and business leaders.

➤ MSc in International Business Economics

This programme is designed for students who wish to deepen their knowledge of economics in an international context, and to broaden their skills and competencies in this very interesting and profitable field.

➤ BA in International Relations and European Studies

This programme is ideal for students who want to understand how the world works, and who wish to work in the fields of diplomacy, international politics, non-governmental organizations, or international business.

➤ MA in International Relations

Students will deepen their knowledge of international politics, as well as gain skills and competencies necessary to succeed in international organizations and institutions. As part of the programme, students may choose to specialize either in **European Administration** or **Leadership and Statecraft**

PROGRAMS IN POLISH

FACULTY OF ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT

➤ BA in Management

This programme is designed for those who wish to pursue careers as managers. As part of the programme, students may choose a specialisation such as: Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Interactive Marketing, Organization and Management, or Human Resource Management.

➤ BA in Economics

The programme is designed to train students in the application of fundamental economic knowledge to real-life managerial, financial, ethical, and analytical problems encountered in business and economics.

➤ MA in International Relations

This programme is ideal for students who are interested in an international career either in business, politics, or in non-governmental organizations. Experts with years of professional and academic experience teach the programme.

➤ BA in Finance and Accounting

This programme is ideal for students who wish to learn about the functioning of financial institutions, or who wish to start a career in banking or financial consulting. As part of the programme, students may choose specialisations in Banking and Financial Counselling, or Innovation and Entrepreneurship.

➤ BA in International Relations

This programme is for people who wish to learn about politics, business, and law in an international context. Students may choose specialisations in International Trade or European Studies as part of their curriculum.

➤ MA in Economics

This programme offers comprehensive training in the areas economic and business analysis. Here students will deepen their understanding of markets and economic transactions, and will receive the skills necessary to become competent and proficient economists.

PROGRAMS IN POLISH

FACULTY OF LAW AND ADMINISTRATION

➤ BA in Administration

This programme is intended to teach students about the functioning of government institutions and administrative organizations, and to train them for future careers as public administrators.

➤ MA in Administration

This programme is for students who wish to pursue a career in public administration in governmental institutions. There are several specialisations available within the programme to give a comprehensive overview of how public administration works and functions.

➤ MA in Law

This is a combined BA and MA programme that lasts 5 years. Through this programme students will be taught about the Polish legal system in terms of corporate and criminal law, and will be trained to work as legal advisors, lawyers, attorneys, judges, or government and public administration officials.

➤ PhD in Law

The PhD in Law programme is for accomplished lawyers and legal scholars who wish to receive a doctorate in Polish law, according to Polish regulations. The programme operates in a loose seminar format where students work closely with their supervisors to complete a doctoral dissertation.

LANGUAGE COURSES

➤ Two-semester language course

Candidates who have a beginner language skill level in **Polish or English** may enrol in a year-long, two semester language course before they begin regular academic programmes. The language courses begin in October and run until June. Once candidates achieve an advanced language skill level they may proceed to study the Bachelor's or Master's Degree programme of their choosing.

➤ One semester language course

The one semester language course is for candidates who have an intermediate or lower intermediate language skill level. Candidates may choose to study **Polish or English**, and once they achieve an advanced language skill level they may enrol in a regular Bachelor's or Master's Degree programme. The one semester language course runs from February until June.

➤ Two month language course

Candidates who wish to study at Lazarski University but with an upper intermediate language skill level in **Polish or English** may enrol in a two-month language classes before the start of the academic year. Classes begin in the middle of July and run until the end of September. Once candidates achieve an advanced language skill level, they may proceed to study a Bachelor's or Master's Degree programme of their choice.

➤ One-month language course

All candidates applying to study at Lazarski University must possess advanced skills in the language in which they wish to study – either **Polish or English**. Candidates whose language skills are slightly below the required level may take a one-month language course before the start of the academic year. One-month language courses start at the end of August and run until the end of September.

step 1

Choose a programme of study

Lazarski University's Admission Team will verify your documents. After your payment has been confirmed and a positive decision is made regarding your application, you will be informed and you will receive the necessary documents for your visa application

PROGRAMMES OF INTERNATIONAL LAW

➤ LL.M. IN TRANSNATIONAL COMMERCIAL PRACTISE

The LL.M in Transnational Commercial Practice programme is run in conjunction with the Centre for International Legal Studies (CILS) in Salzburg, Austria and Boston University, USA.

This programme provides an emphasis on international business, trade, dispute resolution, and the cross-border practice of law. The programme is spread over 3 cycles that can be completed in a one, two or three year period in 2017. Cycles are taught in Budapest in Warsaw.

➤ INTERNATIONAL LEGAL SKILLS PROGRAMME

The International Legal Skills Programme is a joint programme with the Centre for International Legal Studies (CILS) in Salzburg, Austria, and has a strong emphasis on practical learning. Global forces are impossible to escape in today's interconnected world; as a result, professionals who can effectively handle issues on an international level and can operate in multiple legal systems are in increasing demand. This is a two-semester programme, with meetings once a month, during weekends. Some courses are also taught on weekdays as two-week long evening classes.
