**Subject, purpose and justification of the topic**

International aviation has been existing for more than 100 years. From the beginning this activity has caused both legal and financial problems, but in a completely different dimension and character than at present.

The importance of aviation in the European Union is constantly growing. Similar tendencies are sometimes noticeable even faster in other regions of the world than in Europe. The abolition of internal borders within the single European Union market and the tendency to lower the prices of air services caused by various factors, including the opening of the sky within the EU and the liberalization of the air transport market, cause a continuous increase in air traffic. This significantly affects the increase of transport performance.

Today, more and more often, the aviation transport displaces other means of transport. However, it should be emphasized that this applies particularly to low-cost airlines (low-cost). Low-cost carriers are undoubtedly very popular. Remaining on the market in which consumers mostly choose the cheapest offers raises many problems, and forces a number of financial movements on the part of airlines. The question still arises as to how to reduce the costs of conducting aviation activities so as not to fall out of the market, providing services at a sufficiently high level for the lowest possible price. Considering the costs an

airline must incur (which I am writing about in this monograph), also other costs (I mean the costs associated with obligations to protect the rights and interests of air tourists in aviation and tourism law), as well as to ensure aviation safety and air travel. It is also impossible to ignore the costs associated with environmental protection. Currently, we are dealing with increased inclusion of environmental protection (reduction of the share of greenhouse gas emissions, noise, air pollution) to the air transport policy. It should be pointed out that nowadays we can speak not only about the tendency of only a regional range, but a global tendency. On the part of air carriers, however, it increases the costs of conducting aviation activities.

It is also impossible to ignore the increase in insurance rates due to the risk of war or terrorism. The events of September 11 forced the definition of insurance requirements and liability of aircraft users against third parties including terrorist attacks and war risk. In this case the problem concerns the costs of covering damages exceeding the existing insurance guarantees by introducing appropriate collective international quasi insurance. Inclusion of war and terrorist risks in the insurance remains an unresolved issue, but this is not the subject of consideration in this study.

The legal issues of aviation financing in the European Union, with particular emphasis on Poland, concern financing in a broad sense. The content of the monograph covers various aspects of the economic activity of aviation, including various charges imposed by law on airline companies, as long as it affects the financial condition of aviation. The subject matter touched upon in the monograph focuses on legal issues which are very important yet at the same time not fully discussed in literature both in Poland and abroad.

The deepening financial crisis has caused the need to strengthen the financial situation of the aviation industry, which is not easy due to its nature. This issue is complicated by the fact that the applicable legal norms have different sources (international conventions, international regional law - European Union law, and internal law, however issues related to the scope of the relevant provisions are not always clear). The changes introduced in The European Union law, as well as the Aviation Law Acts, force the aviation industry to constantly take action in this area, however, this does not always bring the desired effect. The knowledge contained in this monograph will facilitate proper interpretation and application of relevant rules and legal instruments in the conduct of authorities and aviation institutions and consumers of air services.

The aim of the monograph is to systematically present and analyze the system of multi-level legal status analysis (international, EU and national law) and containing threads

from various legal disciplines (aviation, administrative, civil, economic and financial law). It is also important to determine whether there are any clear trends in the development of this law, as well as to assess whether certain international and EU requirements are being met in the Polish legal system. The author also attempted to determine the relationship and possible conflicts between the relevant general international regulations and EU regulations.

Aviation in the modern world thanks to advances in technology, safety and efficiency of operations in the conditions of the progressive liberalization of personal and economic turnover in the global and regional panel is developing under the rule of law, which supports or limits this development. The question therefore arises whether the existing rules and legal provisions constitute a coherent system corresponding to the general requirements of correct, sustainable development or at least rationalization of the development of the discussed sector. Therefore, it was reasonable to conduct comprehensive research to answer these issues.

## **Research Method**

The monograph was prepared with the dominant use of the comparative legal research and system method. The methodology of work is complex, multifaceted, comprising system analysis of legal regulations relating to the financial aspects of civil aviation activities in an interdisciplinary approach. The legal dogmatic method was applied, concentrating on a special analysis of the provisions of international, European and national law. The research goal was implemented thanks to the use of language interpretation rules, which was supported by subsequent methods, the already mentioned system and functional method. For the legal dogmatic issues, the comparative legal and historical method was used to show the changes that took place and to show how historical events are shaped by the applicable law.

Within the adopted main research method the author has made a detailed analysis of the provisions of international law with particular reference to the provisions of the Chicago Convention of December 7, 1944 and relevant provisions of European Union law (especially ordinances), and the case law of the Court of Justice of the European Union and internal law (especially the Act of July 3, 2002, aviation law). The applied research method forced to present the achievements of the legal doctrine, especially aviation and financial law. In order to show a wider perspective, the author also presented the achievements of foreign doctrine.

The study contains an analysis and comparison of international, European and national law, in order to indicate the relationships between these systems. It is about exploring the extent to which international goals, norms and recommendations at higher levels

(conventional and adopted under international conventions, worldwide) are compatible or at least compatible in regional (EU) law at the executive level - under national law.

Cross-sectoral regulated issues are only mentioned, whereas regulations concerning aviation itself, in various areas of aviation activity are discussed in detail. It was necessary to take into account regulations not only directly related to aviation financing, but also of indirect economic and financial importance for it. Therefore, the author entered various aviation departments of international law, including EU and national - civil, administrative and economic.

### **Research thesis**

The author has adopted a preliminary research hypothesis that there are certain tendencies in multilevel air transport regulations leading to the unification of certain rules to ensure the free and proper development of this transport without discrimination of flags and carriers, at the same time becoming independent of the economic activity on the basis of its self-financing with the limitation of financial public aid.

### **Dissertation structure**

Extensive issues as well as the accepted research thesis influenced the thesis layout. Legal regulations are instruments for the implementation of state policies, in particular economic policy in the air transport sector. The analysis begins with the general characteristics of the air transport regulation system by systematizing the subject of research with the separation of general issues concerning the whole regulation of air transport, and then presenting specific regulations regarding the financial side of aviation in international and domestic trade.

In the texts of international, European and national aviation law, no thesis can be found of such a wide range of research and general assessments.

The monograph consists of an introduction, ten chapters and a summary. It has been divided into two parts. The first one is entitled: Financing aviation as a subject of legal regulation. The second one: Financing certain aviation activities. Each part includes an introduction and a summary.

The layout of the dissertation has been structured as follows:

- in Part I: general principles and legal conditions create the background for detailed considerations.
- Part II: the regulations concerning various spheres of aviation activity, in particular:

1. development and investment programs;
2. administration and aviation supervision;
3. airports and airport staff and services;
4. air navigation services;
5. specific rules regarding the financing of certain services and activities;
6. air transport services;
7. protection of the interests of the injured parties.

The first chapter has an introductory nature. For this reason, the author began her deliberations by presenting the economic and political conditions of aviation financing.

In the second chapter, the sources of law regulating the financing of civil aviation were characterized. Essentially, international aviation finance law is very important to meet - ensuring financial stability in the aviation industry. This law does not constitute a coherent system (or subsystem), because it comes from various sources independent of each other, in which we find the norms of law relating to various departments and entities of aviation activity. In fact, only these specific aviation standards are the subject of research in this work. Bearing in mind the above, the author referred to:

1. universally accepted rules of customary law;
2. international agreements with a supra-regional scope;
3. international agreements with a regional scope;
4. international bilateral agreements;
5. European Union law;
6. internal law.

In particular, international treaty law of supra-regional scope has been specifically analysed, including in particular: the Chicago system and other partially aviation acts including General Agreement on Trade in Services (GATS) and others, also European law preceding EU acts (ECAC/JAR/EUROCONTROL) as well as EU law and national law implementing international law.

In turn, the third chapter has been subject to a detailed analysis of the issue of aviation financing and it is the main subject of the author's research. In the dissertation, covering the legal and financial problems of the diversified scope of aviation activity, the research focuses, without a deeper analysis of the general concepts and principles of financial law, on special rules relating successively to the various spheres of aviation activity concerned. This concerns in particular sources of financing and funding of liabilities in

specific spheres of this activity - public and private - as well as mutual obligations and financial problems.

The financing of certain aviation activities is the subject of the research described in the second part of the work. In the fourth chapter, the author drew particular attention to general development programs and investment programs. Programs realized under the auspices of ICAO, EU programs and implemented thanks to the European Union were discussed.

The Chicago Convention provides for various other forms of cooperation in the implementation and financing of international improvements of air navigation facilities at airports (Articles 69 to 76). The convention allows, for instance, conclusion of an agreement with the Council for the implementation of recommendations, preceded by consultations to improve the facilities for air navigation. This takes place when the Council is of the opinion that airports or other facilities for the air navigation of any Contracting State, including radio and meteorological services, are not sufficient for the safe, regular, efficient and economic operation of existing or proposed international air services. The evaluation criterion in this respect, according to art. 69 of the convention, is "the reasonable assessment".

The Council may create funds or arrange, in whole or in part, airports or other facilities only at the "request of a Contracting State". The Council may obtain funds that should be returned to States. Some projects are implemented in separate agreements, for example regarding services on the North Atlantic (ICAO Doc 9586). It concerns the joint financing of facilities for air navigation in Iceland.

Other arrangements concern regional air navigation organization programs according to ICAO guidelines. New projects are being undertaken, e.g. on the development of satellite navigation (Doc 9750, Doc 9849). It should be pointed out that the Global Air Navigation Plan for CNS/ATM Systems (Doc 9750) recognizes the global satellite navigation system (GNSS) constituting an essential element of communication, navigation and surveillance systems in the air traffic management (CNS/ATM) process, as well as being the basis for building improved services and air navigation services by countries.

Sources of funding for entities operating in civil aviation within the European Union include the following measures:

1. funds from international institutions and arrangements, especially EU ones,
2. national public funds,
3. fees covering the costs of administration, infrastructure and air navigation services,

4. inflows from the market activities of airlines.

In the fifth chapter of the monograph, the aviation administration bodies that participate in the processes of financing specific aviation activities have also been subjected to characteristics.

On the other hand, the purpose of the sixth chapter was to show how free access to European Union airports operates as a result of the liberalization of the air transport market. As part of free access, a system of rules governing the use of airports was created. In particular, it concerns fees, as well as the rules for allocating the time of operations at airports and various ground handling services based on market laws and fair competition. The detailed regulations relevant to the financing of airports, including public aid, commitments regarding devices in the vicinity of the airport, and all charges related to environmental protection were also analyzed in detail.

The seventh chapter was devoted to financing in the area of air navigation services. Indeed, the state's full and exclusive sovereignty in airspace results in a number of different consequences, including, above all, the right to regulate the access of foreign aircraft to its airspace and the right to introduce charges for the use of airports and facilities for air navigation by foreign ships. States regulate these principles, including bilateral international agreements, and regulating it in internal law. The Chicago Convention, which has been discussed many times, is of fundamental importance. Therefore, there is talk of the existence of a Chicago-bilateral system. The system assumes that the air freedoms granted to each other also include the right to use appropriate air navigation services.

Chapter eight of the discussed monograph deals with specific provisions regarding the financing of certain services and activities, including scientific research and teaching of aviation issues, training and checking the qualifications of airline personnel, etc.

The last two chapters are devoted to:

1. access to the market, including issues of ownership and control of air transport companies,
2. air transport tariffs,
3. rules on competition in air transport,
4. leasing of aviation equipment,
5. taxation of air transport.

## **Conclusions (research results)**

The analysis of legal regulations and case law of the Court of Justice of the European Union and the courts of national and administrative national authorities confirms the hypothesis that the existing system is developing towards unification of law with exclusion of discrimination in international relations and extending the scope of free competition, and at the same time the self-financing of the aviation industry excluding public aid.

This is reflected in the conclusions formulated by the author:

1) in the last decades, it is noticeable that the general tendencies in international regulations, especially of the European Union, are strengthening through:

- a) liberalization of market access;
- b) non-discrimination (with national treatment of foreign entrepreneurs);
- c) the application of general rules on the protection of competition and consumers (and third parties).

2) the development of new standards:

- a) tightening safety requirements - aviation itself and persons at risk of damage related to aviation in view of emergence of new risks, which leads to higher insurance costs;
- b) tightening the requirements of financial standing of air carriers (ensuring both compliance with safety and solvency requirements);
- c) maximum satisfaction of consumers' expectations from the most developed countries, which creates additional financial liabilities for aviation (and it burdens all consumers through air fares)
- d) also in the field of legal regulations in the field of aviation incomes and costs incumbent on aviation aiming at self-financing of aviation activities and limiting state aid.

Unfortunately, the above standards lead to the development of "wild" aviation activity, which is also ineffective whereas they should favor the best.

## **4. Discussion of other scientific and research achievements**

My previous academic achievement includes 59 scientific publications, 54 of which, were issued after obtaining the degree of Doctor of Law.

In addition to the topic of the monograph discussed above, the publications cover not only legal and aviation topics, but also other areas of international law, European law and

internal law. A common feature of all scientific publications is that they concern current issues related to numerous changes in international, European and national law, which also require resolving the difficulties arising from possible collisions of multifaceted regulations. The author's aspiration was to present views and decisions for newly emerging problems not yet sufficiently included in the current literature. The author also took into account the problems concerning the law in force in Poland, as well as those that might be of interest to other Central European countries (Ukraine, Slovakia, Lithuania).
