

Information clause

According to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation GDPR, Journal of Laws UE. No. of 2016, No. 119), we would like to inform you that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Lazarski University with its registered office in Warsaw at ul. Świeradowska 43, 02-662 Warsaw.
2. The administrator has appointed the Data Protection Officer, who can be contacted at - iod@lazarski.edu.pl.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
 - a. conduct registration and participation in the TOLES Legal exam pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. b GDPR - implementation and taking actions to perform the contract,
 - b. implementation of the legitimate interest which is indispensability to establish, investigate or defend against possible claims pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR,
 - c. fulfillment of legal obligations imposed on the Administrator under the provisions of tax law and related to the conduct of the TOLES Legal exam until the statute of limitations on tax receivables / liabilities according to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. c GDPR.
4. Your personal data will be kept by the Administrator for the period necessary to complete the TOLES Legal exam or until any claims are time-barred.
5. The recipients of your personal data will be entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of legal provisions. Personal data may be transferred by us to entities that operate the Administrator's ICT systems and provide ICT tools or provide the Administrator with postal, hosting, cloud or document destruction services, as well as Global Legal English Ltd.
6. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decisions, including profiling.
7. You have the right to request the Administrator to access personal data, the right to rectify it, delete limit processing, and the right to transfer data.
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
9. You have the right to object to the processing of personal data, based on art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR.
10. Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected. Failure to provide data may result in the inability to participate in the TOLES Legal exam.
11. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country / international organization, unless it is required by the legal obligations of the Administrator. In connection with the cooperation within the TOLES Legal exam, your personal data may be transferred to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland on the basis of the adopted on June 28, 2021. by the European Commission of two implementing decisions stating an adequate level of protection of personal data in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
