2. The Controller has designated a Data Protection Officer who may be contacted at iod@lazarski.edu.pl.
3. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of:
 - a. dealing with your application, conducting the LAZARSKI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP Programme, selecting and announcing winners, and granting discounts, in accordance with Article 6 par. 1 (f) GDPR, which is the implementation of the LAZARSKI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP Programme, conducting educational activities targeting young people, promoting academically able and talented participants of educational programmes and competitions.
 - b. compliance with legal obligations to which the Controller is subject as a result of tax regulations and the award granted in the LAZARSKI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP Programme until tax obligations are barred by the statute of limitations, in accordance with Article 6 par. 1(c) GDPR.
4. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of promoting the LAZARSKI MERIT SCHOLARSHIP Programme and the University's educational offer based on your consent, in accordance with Article 6 par. 1 (a) GDPR.

6. Personal data may be made available to public authorities and bodies or other entities authorised pursuant to the provisions of law. Personal data may be made available to entities that operate the Controller's CIT systems or provide postal, e-mail, cloud, hosting or document shredding tools and services.
7. Your personal data shall not be subject to automated decision-making and profiling.
8. The data subject shall have the right to request that the Controller give them access to their personal data, the right to rectification, the right to erasure, the right to restriction of processing, and the right to data portability. In the event you have given your consent, you shall also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
9. You shall have the right to lodge an objection based on Article 6 par. 1(f) GDPR.
10. You have the right to complain to a supervising authority: The President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
